## Employment Opportunity Capital Department Environmental Systems Technician Permanent Full-Time

### **Qualifications:**

Secondary school graduation diploma and attend courses, maintain affiliation with professional organizations and read relevant periodicals on an on-going basis to maintain current knowledge of industry practices in the operation and maintenance of environmental systems; Class 3 driver's license with airbrakes; knowledge of basic business computer software including word processing and spread sheets; knowledge of relevant acts and regulations; Good working knowledge of Little Salmon Carmacks First Nation Land Claims Agreement and Constitution would be desirable; Must be able to function in a courteous and tactful manner and must be willing to work occasional weekends and call-outs; This position is essential service and therefore the employee must continue to work thorough cold weather and any office closures; Must be physically fit and be able to lift 50lbs. Required training certificates are as follows:

- Small water system certificate
- Small wastewater system certificate
- Bulk water delivery certificate

**Duties:** Reporting to the Utilities Manager, this position is to work in the safe operation, monitoring and maintenance of environmental systems owned by the LSCFN and to provide technical support to the Department of Capital Works in environmental related projects.

### **Water Systems Monitoring:**

- monitor community and residential water systems for compliance with relevant drinking water standards and legislation;
- collect water samples in accordance with accepted practices;
- interpret results of water sampling program and report results to the Utilities Manager on a routine basis;
- provide reports as required to relevant regulatory authorities.
- operate water truck and act as back-up sewer truck operator when required

### **Water Systems Operation:**

- maintain community water systems including monitoring or residual chlorine levels, water consumption, safe preparation and use of chlorine feed solutions, adjusting feed rates and routine maintenance of pumps, freeze protection systems, dis-infection and filtration systems;
- maintain accurate records of all maintenance and operation data.

### **Water Systems Maintenance:**

- perform routine maintenance on water systems including cleaning of well pits and water tanks, shock chlorination and minor repairs as required.

### **Waste Systems Operation and Maintenance;**

- undertake routine monitoring, record keeping and maintenance of sewage and solid waste disposal systems;
- maintain accurate records of operation and maintenance work on waste disposal systems.

### **Laboratory Operations:**

- operate and maintain basic laboratory services for the testing and monitoring of environmental systems.
