Reporting to the Director of Life Long Learning, this position provides administrative and coordination supports to staff, students/participants, and activities within the Northern Tutchone Language Immersion Program. This position is the hub of information/support/connection between students, staff, administration, elders and other supports that are helpful to the overall success of the program. They will directly work with teaching staff to identify what resources maybe required both in the classroom by sourcing materials and subject experts/and/or Elders. As well as make arrangements for learning outside on the land, such as camp/food/land-based activities.

#### Desired Qualifications:

An understanding of how to work in a way that reflects traditional values with respect to language. Familiarity and awareness of LSCFN's government, history, culture, language and strategic plan would be helpful. Direct knowledge of some Northern Tutchone language or a willingness to learn. Prior experience in an administration or program co-ordination position is preferred/or relevant work experience within LSCFN government is desired. Ability to effectively work with partners internally and externally.
