

Little Salmon Carmacks First Nation COVID ALERT

Issued by LSCFN Chief and Council:

Due to the rising number of COVID-19 cases, LSCFN Council is advising all citizens and LSCFN administration that:

For the next 2 weeks, LSCFN administration buildings will be closed to public. Public access will be based on appointments only. LSCFN administration will continue to offer essential services with limited number of staff working from office while others working remotely.

Masks will be mandatory inside all LSCFN administration buildings and facilities and all COVID-19 safety guidelines will be strictly followed.

This advisory is in effect until November 22nd. However, the Chief and Council will re-evaluate the situation on a regular basis to determine further course of action.

We also advise you to consider getting your vaccinated. If you need assistance, please call LSCFN Health & Social at 867-863-5134 or Carmacks Health Centre at 863-4444 and they can assist you.

We remind all community members to continue to follow the safe 6 plus 1:

- Keep your distance, wear your mask
- Keep your hands clean
- If you feel sick, stay home
- Avoid crowds
- Consider the risks before travelling
- Self-isolate, if necessary, this means not going out and not having people over

We ask that citizens do their part to reduce spread:

- refrain from gatherings in your home, now is not the time to party;
- if you have symptoms, you must stay home;
- the Chief Medical Officer stresses that if you have any chronic medical conditions or addictions, you must take extra precautions because you are more at risk of having severe symptoms should you get COVID; and
- **get vaccinated.**

Please be kind to one another, let's be supportive, this is a very tough time but we will get through this together.
