Duties and Responsibilities:

The Adult Care Worker undertakes domestic duties in the client's home as approved by the Home Care Coordinator and in accordance with the details in the job description. Adult Care Workers perform their duties with respect for the needs and wishes of the client. This position includes the following duties:

- Perform general household cleaning including (washing dishes; wiping down counters, cupboards, and stove; cleaning out fridge weekly; sweeping & mopping floors; vacuuming, making beds; cleaning bathroom; dusting).
- Assist with laundry: (towels and bedding).
- Plan a menu & prepare meal as needed.
- Provide supportive care to the client and support/assist client in activities of daily living:
- Demonstrate knowledge of client's routine and lifestyle;
- Encourages client independence in the performance of appropriate tasks;
- Allow client to make own decision unless otherwise instructed;
- Demonstrate empathy and kindness in communicating with the client and family;
- Demonstrate an ability to listen objectively; to accept client's beliefs, values and lifestyle; and to take them into consideration when carrying out assignment;
- Refrain from imposing own beliefs, values and lifestyle on client and family;
- Demonstrate respectful behavior when providing care.
