Qualifications:

A grade 12 Academic with successful completion of at least two years post-secondary education in the field of Health and Social services; *or* individual course work in the field; *or* several years of experience in the field through paid or volunteer service; *or* an equivalent combination of education, training and work and life experience in a First Nation's environment. A Criminal Record Check and First Aid/CPR Certification must be provided.

Duties:

- Promotion of breast feeding, healthy infant feeding and family planning
- Support to improve access to sufficient and nutritious food through community kitchen activities
- Distribute prenatal nutritious supplements (food, prenatal multivitamins recommended by a registered dietician or physician)
- Conduct dietary assessment for each client and provide the necessary nutritional counseling
- Assist clients to develop skills in food preparation, portion size, food groups, traditional vs. store bought foods, shopping on a budget, infant feeding
- Coordinate prenatal health clinics, mother's and father's group, home visits, drop-in-centers, parenting classes, and oral health
- Support and encourage the use of FN's traditional medicine, health practices, and positive First Nation's parenting
- Provide support and implement teen parent programming
- Provide opportunities for Elders to talk to new mothers, new fathers and pregnant women about what to expect with labor, delivery and parenting
- Ensuring the participation of expectant mothers and fathers in the planning and delivery of their baby through home visits, including family members, and supporting transportation to medical appointments
- Working with the Daycare and the school in promoting healthy diets and family planning
- Other duties as required
